As part of the work of the Intellectual Output O2 "Framework of cross-border skills", the partners of the ECBS project have implemented and designed a **European Cross-border Skills Framework (ECBS Framework)**.

The ECBS Framework is composed by **15 skills** that have been identified and defined within the framework. The skills are the following:

- \* Communication
- \* Intercultural sensitivity
- \* Adapting
- \* Teamwork and collaboration
- \* Problem-solving
- \* Learning
- \* Conflict resolution and negotiation
- \* Organisation and time-management
- \* Critical thinking
- \* Strategic and innovative thinking
- \* Decision-making
- \* Leadership
- \* Systems thinking
- \* Work ethic / conscientiousness
- \* Service orientation
